

Bar Charts Checklist

Drawing a bar chart	
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have written the numbers on the lines of graph paper, not in the spaces.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have checked that the numbers for the scales go up in equal numbers.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have remembered to check the scale when plotting points.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have used a pencil first so that errors can be corrected.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have labelled the horizontal and vertical axes.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have left space between the bars of the chart.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have given the chart a title.
Interpreting a bar chart	
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have read the title and know what the graph represents.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I understand the scale of the x and y axes.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have ensured that I know what the x and y axes represent.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have read the item of each bar correctly.
<input type="checkbox"/>	I have used a ruler to draw a line to the y axis in order to read the scale accurately.
